

EARN & LEARN

A school based traineeship allows students to combine their Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) with an average of 7 hours a week of paid work in their chosen industry. Work placement times are scheduled around school timetables and industry requirements.

Students are also released from their school timetable one afternoon each week for attend a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) where they complete their formal training.

Successful completion of the traineeship also results in student receiving credits towards either their VCE or VCAL. In addition they gain a nationally recognised qualification and valuable industry experience.
